



- LOOP THE LAKE | 23 MI.
 Enjoy beautiful views of the lake on the most popular bike route in this part of the state. This route circles Green Lake and is a combination of on-road and trail riding.

 Parking: Town Square Trailhead, Green Lake
- 2 LAUREE'S TRAIL | 10 MI. | 6.8 MI. | 3.2 MI. These paved multi-use paths connect the Green Lake Conference Center (GLCC) to Ripon. From the trailhead, head west through the GLCC (3.2mi) or east to Ripon (6.8mi). Parking: Town Square Trailhead, Green Lake or at Green Lake Fortiff Bank on Hwy 23
- 3 NORTHWESTERN TRAIL | 2.5 MI.
 This shaded old railroad bed takes bicyclists through the city of Ripon, around Ripon College, past beautiful Victorian homes

- and onto Watson Street to explore a treasure-trove of boutique shops and restaurants. Parking: Along Cty Rd PP north of Hwy 23 Ripon or at the Ripon Public Library, 120 Jefferson Street
- 4 MASCOUTIN VALLEY STATE TRAIL | 11 MI. This trail stretches between Berlin & Ripon along the old Milwaukee railroad bed. A packed limestone base, the trail passes through protected wildlife areas and wetlands. Parking: Lot off Locust Street north of Ripon or lot on State Hwy 49 south of Berlin
- 5 EAST END LOOP | 18 MI.

 This route will take you on an agricultural tour of scenic hills, fields & farmsteads.

 Parking: Town Square Trailhead, Green Lake
- **6** CERESCO PRAIRIE CONSERVANCY MOUNTAIN BIKE TRAIL | 2.5 MI. This trail provides the thrill of jumps and switchbacks with nice climbs for the off-road adventure seekers. Built on the side of a hill, it winds through hardwoods and tall prairie grasses. Open in winter for fat-tire cycling. Parking: Lot behind Ripon College Willmore Center at 400 Union Street, Ripon
- Visit Big and Little Green Lake as your climb the hills between glacial drumlins and farmland. Pack a picnic and end your ride with a refreshing dip in Big Green Lake. Parkina: Dodae Memorial County Park

- 8 HUCKLEBERRY LOOP | 22 MI.
 Enjoy the quiet rolling back country paved roads of Green Lake County. This trail crosses Snake Creek and continues to the Fox River.
 Parking: The 300 Club, Green Lake
- WHITE RIVER MARSH LOOP | 18 MI.

 This route takes you through the White River

 Marsh. This wetland is a bird watching paradise and the home to many whooping cranes.

 Parking: American Legion, Princeton
- This route on paved, rural roads takes you through the rolling hills and farmland.

 Parking: Town Square Trailhead, Green Lake
- **EXT. LITTLE GREEN LAKE LOOP** | 28 MI. A longer version of the Little Green Lake Loop, this route passes through farmland, a sand mine and marshland.

 Parking: Dodge Memorial County Park
- MARQUETTE/GRAND RIVER ROUTE | 16 Ml.
 With views of Lake Puckaway, this route
 will take you through the wetland of Grand
 River Marsh and rural Green Lake County.
 Parking: Doc Meyers Community Park, Kingston
- This route will take you through scenic Amish Country. Explore an Amish bakery, greenhouse, buggy shop or general store along your ride.

 Parkina: Doc Meyers Community Park, Kinaston

HIKING TRAILS



- NORWEGIAN BAY WETLANDS | 0.6 MI.

 A short trail through the woods leads to a boardwalk over the largest area of contiguous wetlands on Green Lake. A sitting bench at the end of the boardwalk overlooks Green Lake.

 Parking: Street parking on Bay Rd, Green Lake
- 2 ASSEMBLY CREEK & SPRINGS/
 HAMMERS TRAIL | 0.7 MI.
 This property includes 1,100 feet of Green
 Lake frontage and a hiking loop (Hammer's
 Trail) with five bridges over several creeks and
 springs. The waterways merge into Assembly
 Creek, which flows into Norwegian Bay.
 Parking: Lot at trail head west of Green Lake
 Conference Center's Tea House
- WINNEBAGO TRAIL | 0.8 MI.
 This former Native American trail follows the

elevated shoreline along the north shore of Green Lake and offers incredible views of the lake. Near the east end of the property, the trail passes under a historic stone bridge. Parking: Street parking south of Hillside Road in Green Lake Conference Center.

4 FOREST AVENUE OAK SAVANNA

Approximately 1 acre to explore, this property is located in the City of Green Lake. It is home to native oak savanna with a sitting bench.

Parking: Street parking on Forest Ave., Green Lake

5 HIGHKNOCKER TRAIL

Located in Highknocker Park, this short trail takes you on a leisurely walk through a wooded loop. Let the kids enjoy the park playground equipment before you leave. Parking: Street parking on Highknocker Trail., Green Lake

- 6 SUNNYSIDE CONSERVANCY | 1.5 MI.
 Located along Silver Creek Inlet, this wide,
 level walking trail meanders through a
 mixture of woods and restored prairie. Once
 slated for development, the property features
 several man-made channels and scenic vistas
 of the Silver Creek Estuary.
 - Parking: Lot off Lakeview Drive, Green Lake
- GUSKEY/MILLER PRAIRIE | 1 MI.

 These two adjacent proprieties totalling over
 38 acres consist of restored tallgrass prairie
 with some riparian forest along Silver Creek.
 Parking: Street parking on County Road FF, Ripon

8 POOL'S HILL NATURE PRESERVE SUGAR ISLAND WETLANDS

Pools Hill Nature Preserve contains a wetlands complex that includes wooded openings and rare fen habitat. Pool's Hill is only accessible by water (by boat or ice). Parking: Lot at Sunset Park, Green Lake

MITCHELL GLEN (GUIDED TOURS ONLY)

This spectacular site was formed 12,000 years ago when post-glacial meltwater eroded the sandstone bedrock, resulting in a steep-sided and timbered gorge with a springs at the base. This property is accessible only during two annual guided hikes. To sign up visit www.glakesd.com.

- TULETA HILL PRAIRIE | 0.6 MI.
 Previously farmland, this 7.5 acre property
 is being restored to prairie and oak savanna.
 The prairie features a mowed trail, with sitting
 benches for taking in the natural beauty.
 Parkina: Street parking on Tuleta Hill Rd.
- TICHORA CONSERVANCY | 1 MI.

This 40-acre property along Green Lake's unspoiled south shore also borders Spring Lake to create a riparian habitat for a large diversity of wildlife. An exceptionally scenic property with sandstone cliffs, shallow caves, and towering trees, Tichora features has 800 feet of shoreline along Green Lake with beautiful views of the lake.

Parkina: Lot at trail head off Oakwood Beach Rd.

WICK NATURE PRESERVE

SOUTH WOODS | 3+ MI.

This property is home to 3.2 acres of southern oak forest/wetlands. No established trails, but visitors can explore the property. Parking: Street parking on Wick Road

- SNAKE CREEK WETLANDS TRAIL | 3 MI. An abandoned railroad grade, this trail takes you through the Snake Creek Wetlands.

 Parking: Street parking on Swamp Rd or St. Marie Rd, Princeton
- A well known nature area in Ripon, South Woods has a variety of natural habitats including a creek that runs through the property. This area, created from the glaciers and flood plain, proves to be a great place to take a hike or to study nature.

 Parking: Lot at trail head, Union St., Ripon
- An old railroad bed rising above lowland habitats and crosses the beautifully preserved Northwestern Railway Bridge that spans over the Fox River.

 Parking: Street parking on Farmer St., Princeton
- RIGGS PARK NATURE TRAILS | 1.75 MI.
 This 300-acre park includes 180 acres of wetlands and 70 acres of native prairie restoration with hiking trails throughout.
 Parking: Lot at trail head, Douglas St., Ripon
